

WHAT DOES THIS 218 FIRE ASSESSMENT ACCOMPLISH?

24/7 staffing at our local station in Felton - paid career firefighters and chief for guaranteed response and fastest service, with a strong core of volunteers backing them up, training with them, and working alongside them, ensuring that FFPD can respond as quickly as possible to each call that comes in, day or night.

Fast, professional, local response = strong ISO ratings, important for insurance costs/availability

Vehicles and equipment in good repair and replaced in a timely manner

A local station in good repair with adequate facilities for our mixed-gender crew of firefighters overnighting at the fire house

Adequate funding for important, costly training, required by the state, for our volunteer firefighters as well as paid staff

Additional support of community groups like CERT (Community Emergency Response Teams) and Firewise, including partnering on a new community chipper program and top-priority defensible space work

Continued passionate dedication to protecting our local community from wildfire and other disaster, as well as providing professional, timely response to medical emergencies

Funds collected from Felton residents for fire service stay in Felton, overseen by a community oversight committee and our locally elected FFPD board (3 seats up for election this November).
